

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting Brandon Road from its junction with High Street to its junction with Mundford Road in the PARISH OF METHWOLD because of Rutterford and Sons installing electrical duct.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 29<sup>th</sup> May to 6<sup>th</sup> June 2021 for the duration of the works expected to be about 9 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Brandon Road, Stoke Road, Main Road, Methwold Road, Whittington Hill, Thetford Road, Cranwich Road, Lynn Road, Swaffham Road Roundabout, Mundford Road, Peppers High Hill, Lodge Road (Feltwell Mundford/ Northwold/ Weeting-with-Broomhill/ Methwold/ Hockwold cum Wilton/ Cranwich).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

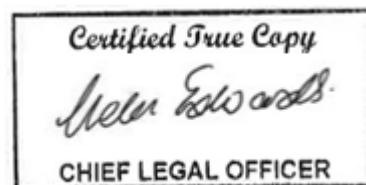

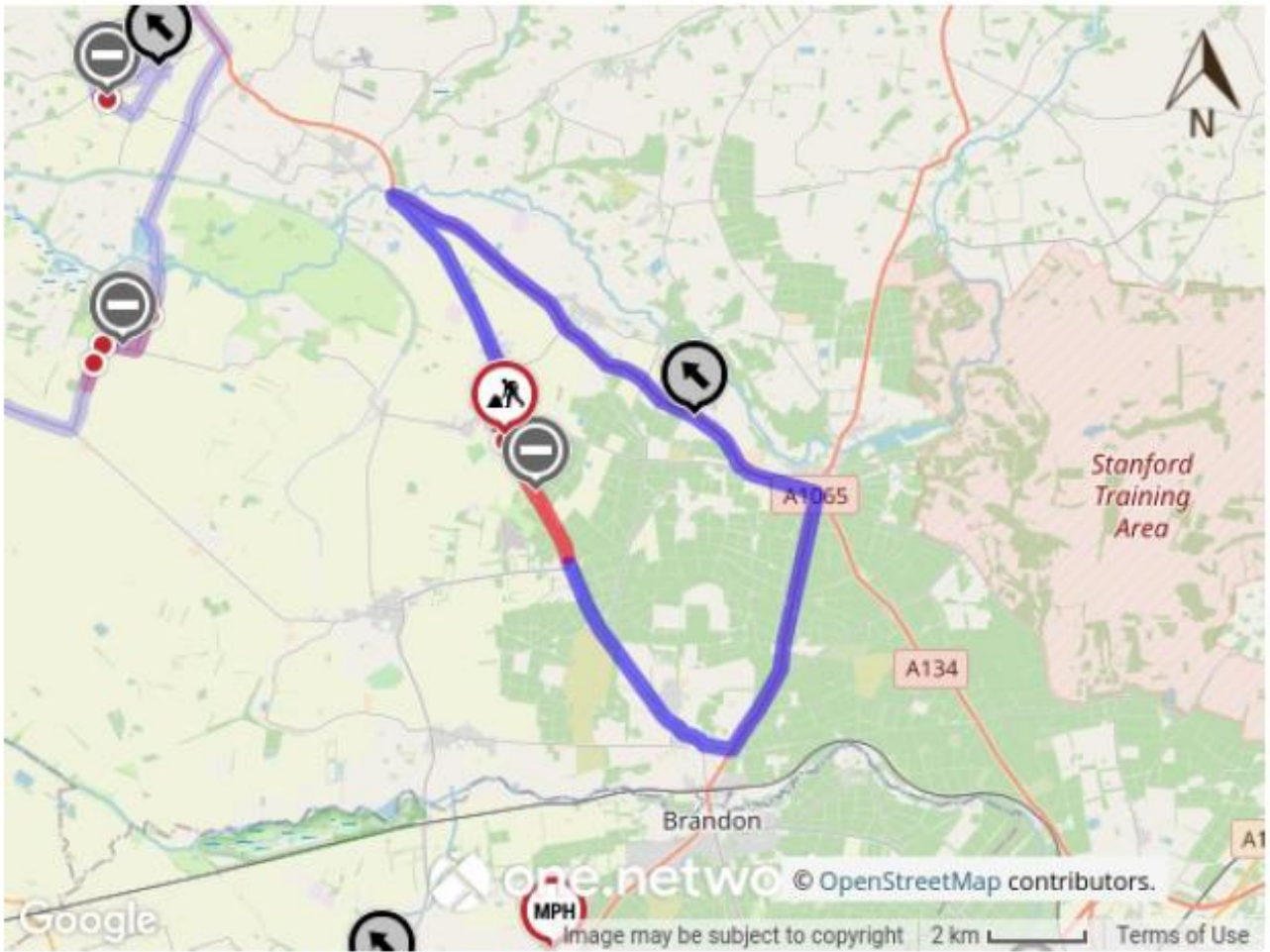
